We will award individual scholarships to the top qualified student applicants, with the dollar amount and the number of Awards to be determined by the Club's Scholarship Judges. Parents/Guardians/Applicants MUST reside and have a permanent address in Northeast Tarrant County, using zip codes officially designated by the Association of Former Students, as shown on our Club Website Scholarship Page. Do not apply if you do not reside in those zip codes.

- Criteria for Scholarship Award: Academic Performance, Character and Leadership Contributions (including extracurricular involvement and community and volunteer services), and responses to three Essay Questions.
- Official High School Transcript is required for application review, with same **USPS mail postmark deadline of February 15, 2025.**
- The Award Selection Process may or may not include an interview for select candidates. You will be notified.
- Scholarship Award Payment for Winners will be sent to the Texas A&M Registrar for application to student's account upon receipt of recipient's official registration information from Texas A&M University.
- We will ask our Scholarship Award Winners to send a photo with permission to share on our Club's social media, if willing.
